## Church Electoral Roll

2019 is the year in which all  
Church Electoral Rolls are  
renewed. This means that  
**everyone comes off and must  
re-apply** if they wish to be on  
the Electoral Roll.

Between **17th Feb and 31st  
March** you will have the  
opportunity to complete a new  
Electoral Roll form (regardless if  
you have completed one in the  
last few months). **Only those** on  
the Electoral Roll can vote at the  
Annual Meeting or apply to be  
on the PCC. If you are not on the  
Roll please consider joining (you  
need to be over 16, baptised and  
either live in the parish or have  
worshipped here regularly for  
at least 6 months). Application  
forms are available in the church  
entrance area. Completed forms  
must be returned to the Church  
Office no later than 13th April.
